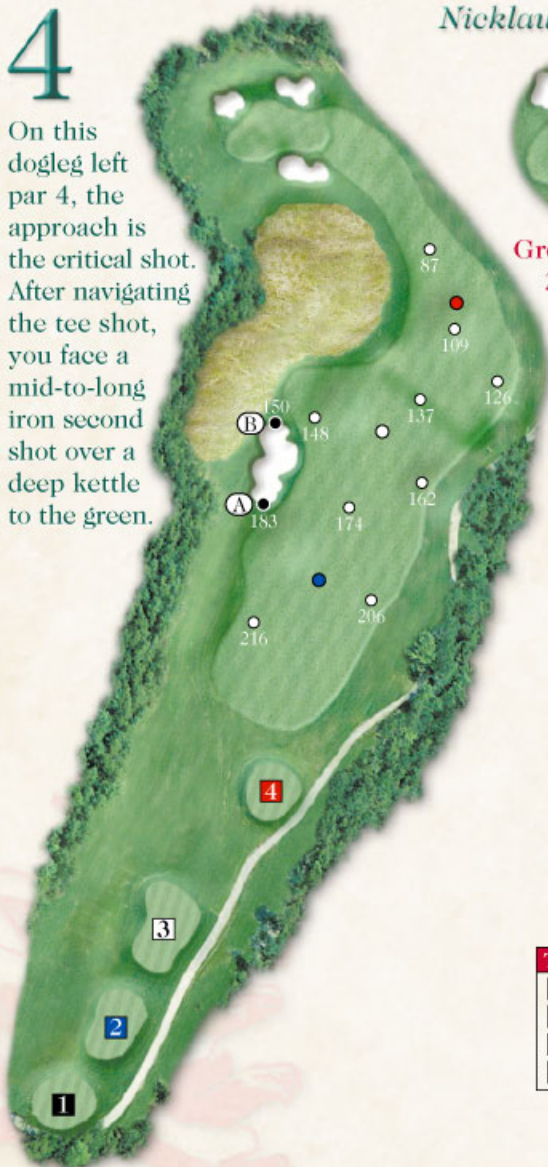

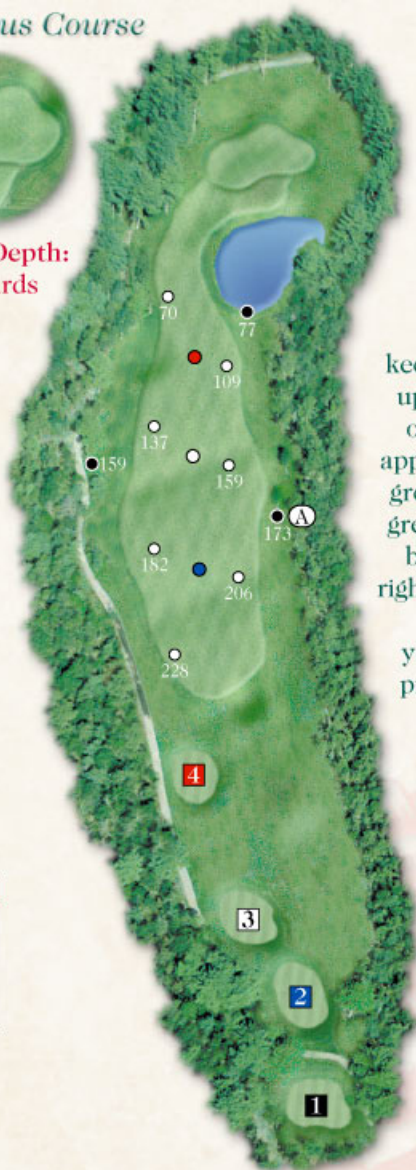

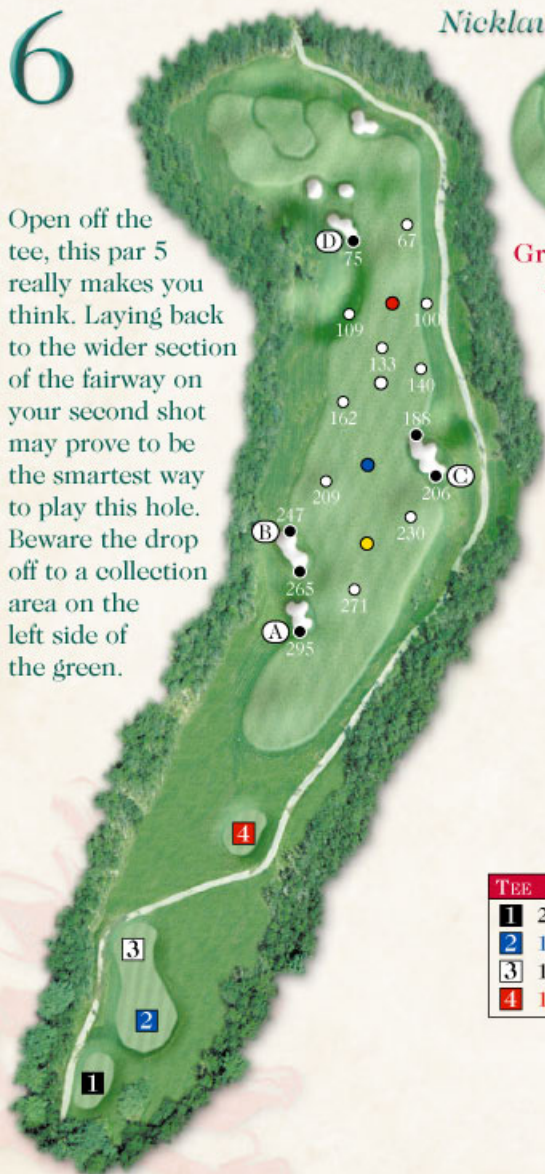

This strong par 4 challenges all golfers and plays more downhill than it appears. Keep your drive on the left side for the best angle to the green. A sharp drop off on the front right side of the green forces you to carry the ball onto the green.
